must be holders and in possession  
of a current racing licence.

In the interest of safety, Coaches are  
required not to enter crews of  
insufficient watermanship skill.

The draw and any other  
documentation will only be sent  
out electronically to the primary  
e-mail address as listed on BROE,  
and will also be put onto the  
Peterborough website.

Racing will be under the new British Rowing Competition Framework using the personal ranking index system. Events will be split into bands of competitors/crews using ranking indices at the discretion of the Regatta Committee.
