IMPORTANT NOTES

- 1 Doubling up is at own risk. Competitors may not race in more than two events each day and boats may not be used in more than 2 events per day.
- 2 At the discretion of the Regatta Committee an entry limit of 350 per day may have to be imposed and entries in any one event may have to be limited to 16. If entry limits are exceeded entries may be closed earlier and preference will be given to entries paid for at the time of the draw.
- 3 Race details will be emailed to your club Online Entry account address so you must ensure that this is up to date.
- 4* Winners' pewter tankards will only be presented upon production of British Rowing race licences with photographs)

Racing will be under the new British Rowing Competition Framework using the personal ranking index system.

Senior events will be split into bands of competitors/crews using ranking indices at the discretion of the Regatta Committee. For Masters events the ranking indices may be used at the discretion of the Regatta Committee to achieve fairer racing if the levels of entries are sufficient.
